INTRODUCTION

The Annual Convention (Jalsa Salana) of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Jamā'at Canada is a unique event that brings over 20,000 participants and thousands of people worldwide to enhance their religious knowledge, and spirituality, and promote a sense of peace in society and brotherhood.

Eminent speakers, scholars, and dignitaries deliver speeches discussing a range of various religious topics and their relevance to contemporary society. Additionally, several parliamentarians, civic leaders, and diplomats from different countries have addressed the gathering attendees and complimented the convention's objective of enhancing unity, understanding peace, and mutual respect.



The Blessed Words of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him)

The Ahmadiyya Muslim Jamā'at was established in 1889 by Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (peace be upon him) in Qadian, India. With divine guidance, he claimed to be the Promised Messiah and Imam Mahdi, whose arrival had been anticipated by all religions worldwide. General Information

Ahmadi Muslims from around the globe are cordially invited to participate in Jalsa Salana Canada. Individuals coming from countries other than Canada are required to present a "Letter of Invitation" provided by their respective National Amir/President.

Hospitality Period

The Canada Jamā'at aims to ensure a delightful and convenient experience for Jalsa guests. From July 4th to 8th, 2024, the Canada Jamā'at will accommodate guests who are from outside of Canada.

Please be aware that guests arriving before or staying after the designated hospitality period will need to arrange their accommodation and meals. It is important to note that the availability of accommodations at Baitul Islam Mosque during the hospitality period will be limited.



Non-Ahmadi friends

Non-Ahmadi acquaintances can also be extended an invitation to participate in the Jalsa Salana. Non-members Guests must register at <https://jalsa.askislam.ca/> in advance.

Registration

Admission to the Jalsa Salana Site: To gain access to the Jalsa Salana site, all attendees must possess a computerized registration ID card issued by the Jamā'at. Canadian participants are kindly asked to bring their AIMS ID cards along with them.

Buses from Various Jamā'ats

To ensure a smooth journey to the Jalsa Gah, we highly recommend utilizing public transportation or dedicated bus services. For more information, kindly reach out to your local president.

Driving to Jalsa Gah

If you plan to utilize your vehicle for transportation to the Jalsa, we kindly request that you carpool and ensure all seats in your vehicle are occupied. To secure parking on-site, we recommend arriving at least two hours before the commencement of the Jalsa session.

Parking Enforcement

The Jamā'at has made arrangements with the Local Authority, Police, and Highway Authorities to regulate the flow of vehicles entering and exiting the Jalsa Gah.

It is crucial for Jamā'at members to adhere to these guidelines and strictly abide by traffic regulations. It is essential to drive responsibly and avoid exceeding speed limits. Failure to do so will harm the reputation of the Jamā'at.

Parking Enforcement

Please be aware that the routes to the Jalsa gah may change, and it is highly recommended that you visit the Jalsa Salana Canada Website for any updates or modifications.

Furthermore, please note that the Jamā'at cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage incurred to vehicles within the Jamā'at premises or the Jalsa gah area. Parking or driving your vehicle within Jamā'at premises is at your own risk.

Accommodation

To ensure a seamless and well-structured experience for all attendees of Jalsa Salana, we kindly request that individuals seeking accommodation during Jalsa Salana Canada submit their applications no later than June 1st, 2024.

Accommodation requests will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. It is important to note that any applications received after June 1st may not be guaranteed. However, we will make every effort to accommodate late submissions based on availability.

Therefore, we strongly advise all members to submit their applications before the specified deadline to secure their accommodation arrangements.

To submit your accommodation application or if you have any inquiries, please visit our official website at www.jalsasalana.ca and follow the instructions provided on the Accommodation page.

Hotel Accommodation

Guests are recommended to make their arrangements for hotel accommodations. The Jalsa Salana Administration cannot facilitate the booking of hotel rooms on behalf of any individual guest.

Private Tents & Caravans

Private tents and/or caravans do not have any provisions for accommodation.

Main Car Parking

The primary parking area for Jalsa Salana is located at the Jalsa Gah in Bradford, Ontario. However, there is also an additional offsite parking area available for overflow. Guests can utilize a shuttle service to conveniently transport them from the offsite parking to the Jalsa Gah.

To guide you to the designated parking area, special road signs will be placed along the route. A frequent and comfortable shuttle service will be in operation, continuously shuttling guests between the Car Parking and the Jalsa Gah site.

Disabled Car Passes for Jamā'at members

Arrangements have been made for designated parking spaces for members with disabilities. Only those who possess a valid Disabled Car Pass issued by the government are allowed to enter and park in this designated area. Failing to display a valid disabled parking pass will result in the vehicle being towed at the owner's expense.

Security

We all bear a shared responsibility for our security and the safety of those around us. Everyone must remain attentive and alert. If you observe any behavior, individual, item, or unattended bag that raises suspicion, please promptly inform the security volunteers on duty. If you cannot locate a security volunteer nearby, kindly contact Nazim security at the provided phone number and stay calm.

Children's Safety

To ensure the safety of children, it is recommended to attach essential details such as the child's name, parent's name, Jamā'at name, country, and phone number in English to their wrist or wear around their neck. This information must be enclosed in a plastic cover to protect it from inclement weather conditions.

First Aid & Medical Facilities

Doctors and paramedics will be available at Jalsa Gah on both the ladies and men's sides during Jalsa hours. Medical treatment for minor ailments will be provided free of charge.

Doctors will also be available at designated times at Baitul Islam Mosque

However, if hospital care is needed, guests will be required to pay at the hospital if there is any charge. It should be noted that medical treatment is quite expensive in Canada. The telephone number for Medical Emergency is 911.

To cover such risks, overseas guests are strongly advised to have adequate travel medical insurance coverage during their stay in Canada.

First Aid & Medical Facilities

A written prescription is required from a Registered Canadian Doctor for the purchase of medicines in Canada. If you require medicines, you are advised to bring a certificate or a prescription with you from your doctor explaining the nature of your ailment and the medicines that you need to take. The doctor will need this information before he/she assists you.

If you have dietary requirements or allergies, please take extra care consuming food at the Jalsa Salana Canada.

Amanat, Lost & Found

If you find or misplace money or any other valuable item, please report it to the Amanat, Lost & Found Office.

Water

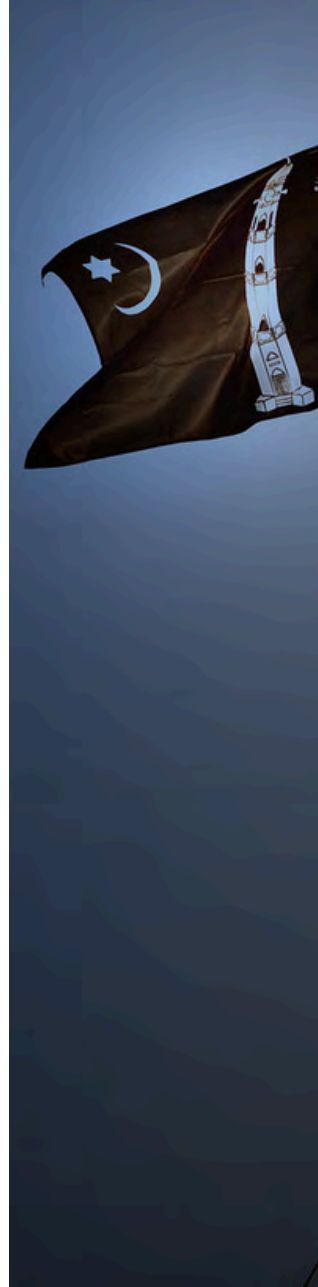
We kindly ask you to be mindful of your water usage and avoid any wastage. Your cooperation in conserving water is highly appreciated.

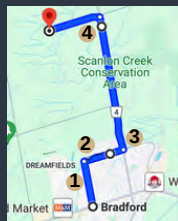

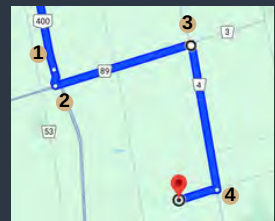
